January 29, 1934 - July 31, 2020

Billy Bryant Doyle, 86 of Cynthiana, Kentucky, died at the University of Kentucky A.B. Chandler Medical Center on July 31, 2020, after a brief illness. The son of Wilfred Owen Doyle, Sr. and Bertha Mae Adams Doyle, Billy was born in Bourbon County Kentucky on January 29, 1934. The youngest of six children, Billy was a farmer and operated a lime hauling business. He was also a representative for Woodman of the World Life Insurance.
