Franklin Miles Hughes (Frankie), widower of Marilyn Boothe Hughes, passed away January 5, 2025, at the age of 92. Frankie was born on Cassidy Creek in Nicholas County, Kentucky to James Miles Hughes and Elizabeth Crawford on August 5, 1932. He grew up on the Clay Farm. After graduating Carlisle High School, he served in the Korean war for the United States Army. Frankie and Marilyn were married October 20, 1956. In their early years, they ran a small restaurant (Little House with The Big Eats) in Carlisle, Kentucky. Frankie served several terms on the Carlisle City Council and 2 terms as the Mayor. He was a member of Carlisle Christian Church, Nicholas County VFW and American Legion. Frankie was a charter member of the Nicholas County Fire Department. He retired from the United States Postal Service. Frankie is survived by three sons; Miles (Dawn) Hughes, Mark (Cindy) Hughes and Matthew (Penny) Hughes, grandchildren; Jeremy, Leah, and Justin Hughes, Cordell Watkins and Samantha Jones, great-grandchildren; Gracie Hughes, Noah and Grant Shanklin, Emma Hughes, Gracey Skaggs, Hudson and Annistyn Jones.
