Lee Newby Peters of Carlisle, Kentucky passed away peacefully the morning of October 4, 2020. She was a native of Valley View, Kentucky and was born on July 22, 1933 to Oscar T. and Jessie Tudor Newby. Following her undergraduate work at Eastern Kentucky University and clinicals at Purdue Affiliate Saint Elizabeth School of Medical Technology in Lafayette, Indiana Lee found her way to Carlisle Kentucky. She had been asked to come to Carlisle to help establish a lab and x-ray unit for the local hospital. Her plan was to stay in Carlisle for one year then begin her career in Florida.
