



## Roy Everett Clark

August 26, 1942 - April 24, 2023

Roy Everett Clark passed away April 24, 2023. He was born on August 26, 1942, in Nicholas County, the son of the late Herman and Thelma McIntyre Clark. He was a graduate of Millersburg Military Institute in 1960 and served in the U S Navy during the Vietnam War. He was a driver for Greyhound Bus Lines for twenty-five years as well as other transportation jobs. Roy was also an avid farmer and electrician and enjoyed collecting antique tractors and other farm equipment. Roy loved to travel and was able to visit nearly all of the United States and parts of Canada during his lifetime. In 1966 he married Joyce Caswell of Carlisle, who preceded him in death in 1992. He is survived by a daughter Michele (James) Deal, two granddaughters Audrey Deal and Hayley (Jimmy) Worstell, a special nephew Ronnie Clark of Carlisle, as well as numerous other nieces and nephews.
